

8th Grade Supplies

Below is a list of supplies your child will need for 8th grade. Please note which items should be labeled with subject titles before bringing them into school. There are also certain supplies that are noted as "to be collected" that teachers will keep in the classroom for resupplying purposes as the year progresses.

- ☐ 1 pencil case
- ☐ 1 box of blue or black pens
- ☐ 1 pack of markers
- ☐ 1 pack of colored pencils
- ☐ 1 pack of crayons
- ☐ 2-3 highlighters
- ☐ 2 black Sharpies
- ☐ 1 pair of scissors
- ☐ 5 glue sticks (2 to keep, 3 to be collected: math, art, science)
- ☐ 6 boxes of pencils (2 to keep, 4 to be collected: math, religion, language arts, art)
- ☐ 1 planner for recording assignments
- ☐ 1 1.5 inch binder (labeled: math)
- ☐ 1 five-subject spiral notebooks (labeled: language arts)
- ☐ 2 composition notebooks (labeled: science, science labs)
- ☐ 3 student choice of spiral or composition books (labeled: social studies, religion, world language)
- ☐ 8 folders (labeled: math, science, social studies, religion, spelling, writing, reading, world language)
- ☐ 4 packs of looseleaf paper (2 to keep, 2 to be collected: math, religion)
- ☐ 2 packs of 3x5 index cards (to be collected: language arts, religion)
- ☐ 1 one-inch binder with pocket dividers (labeled: art)
- ☐ 1 pair of headphones (USB or audio jack plug needed, no Bluetooth)
- ☐ 1 TI-30XIIS calculator (to be collected for storage: math)

**Students should also have access to a calculator that can be kept at home for homework, it doesn't need to be the above calculator

- ☐ 2 rolls of paper towels (to be collected: homeroom, science)
- ☐ 4 boxes of tissues (to be collected: homeroom)
