



All Halloween Activities

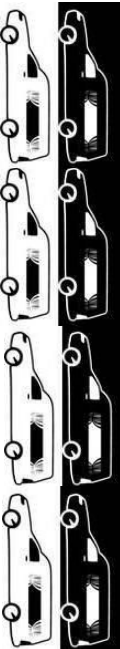
October 31th will be a terrifyingly terrific Tuesday here at CKRS starting with a Morning dance Party in the gym and other Halloween activities and lesson through the morning. The Haunted House theme this year is "Mad Science" This CKRS Tradition is an appropriately scary fun event planned, designed and delivered by the Eighth Grade for children in First grade to Seventh Grade to enjoy. This is an optional Halloween activity is only for those children who wish

to participate. The Haunted House will be offered Monday and Tuesday morning . The cost is \$1.00 donation to benefit the 8th Grade Activity Fund.



The Halloween Parade will be from 11:10 to 11:45 a.m. in the School Gym. Parents and other Guests are invited to arrive between 10:45 -11:05 a.m. and take a seat in the bleachers that will be marked with your child's grade. Please enter by the Back Gym Door for this public event and remain in the gym. Please do not wander about. Having the Parade in the Gym will allow all of our guests to see all the students in the CKRS Halloween Parade. Students will circle the entire floor of the Gym going up and across the stage as a class. They will do this two times , take the stage for a Class Group photo and then gather on the Gym Floor to end of the parade finishing with a dance led by the 8th Grade.

Parents wishing to take their child (ren) home immediately after the parade must sign the early released form and hand it in by Tuesday Morning. You and your child(ren) must leave immediately and do not interfere with the activities and dismissal of the children staying until 12:30. Cars can park in the surrounding streets or be part of a created triple car line in the lower parking lot and Windsor driveway up to Hopkins but not across the street. All families using this special augmented carline option must quickly claim their children and immediately return to their cars following the parade so that the entire car line can then move in unison. NO CARS MAY PARK IN THE EUCLID BUS LOOP. Thank you for your cooperation in making this part of the day a less frightful experience for us all.



Below is some additional Halloween information and guidelines:

- Children will change into their costumes @10:30 for the Parade. The children may dress down on Halloween in either something Black and/or Orange or Halloweeny or of course their Gym uniforms so it is easier to change into their costumes or wear under the costume.
- Students may not put on makeup or use any type of spray (i.e. Hair color). This privilege is reserved for the 8th grade. Masks are permissible but will only be worn during the parade.
- Costumes may not be violent in nature nor sexually suggestive or provocative. Also no scary clowns or disrespectful political costumes are permitted.
- Students may not carry weapons (swords, toy guns, hatchets, etc.) or any weapon like articles in the parade.



Students staying until regular early dismissal must change back into their uniforms before the end of the school day to ride on a bus or walk home that day. Only those leaving with a parent/guardian by car directly after the parade are permitted to stay in full costume. All other must change back into street clothes.
