“ONEdergarten” is an innovated educational solution for **children who have completed Kindergarten** and who have mastered the standard Kindergarten academic skills but who have a social and/or emotional skill set making them seem developmentally young compared to most of their peers. In Onedergarten, late social bloomers and chronologically younger children with a late summer birthday will be afforded more of the TLC (Teacher/Learner Contact) needed to develop and mature while they learn and advance academically as First Grade students.

“Five Things to know about CKRS “ONEdergarten”

- Although a special class grouping, **this is NOT a Special Education Program**
- Our standard CKRS 1st Grade Curriculum will be taught but it will be delivered differently using specific social/emotional instructional methods and materials.
- Class Size will be limited and smaller by design to enable more direct teacher interaction in order to better promote each child’s personal and social growth as a young learner.
- Unlike most Transitional 1st Grade Classrooms (T-1), our goal is for all our “ONEderful” students to confidently and competently move on to 2nd Grade with their CKRS peers.
- All Applicants to “ONEdergarten” will be individually assessed using both academic and social benchmarks to determine their suitability as a potential ONEdergarten candidate.
